Exhibition openings are in salon format and all exhibitors are encouraged to attend. Exhibiting artists are asked to bring finger foods to share.

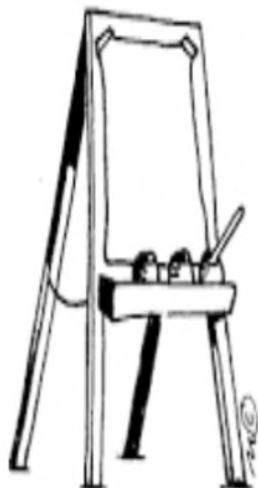
