The program encourages an understanding of the background for denying Indians the right to vote in 1912 and encourages people to think beyond the Three Peoples myth--Indians, Hispanics, and Anglos living in harmony – to the reality of the struggle that began with the Pueblo Revolt of 1680 and continues today.


